INFORMATION

AMADEUS International School Vienna empowers individuals to discover and develop their talents so that they may make positive contributions to our world.

AMADEUS Vienna Scholarships provide the opportunity for students to pursue an excellent academic and arts education that leverages the school's unique international environment and host country opportunities. The programme is based on recognising all-around student excellence. Applicants are required to demonstrate achievement in academics and the arts, as well as to embody the values of AMADEUS Vienna at the highest level.

SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

For the academic year 2021-2022 AMADEUS Vienna is offering the following scholarship opportunities:

- ❖ **Academic Scholarships** to cover the published AMADEUS tuition fees. This scholarship is only available for Grades 11-12 applicants.
- ❖ **Music and Arts Academy Scholarships** for highly talented musicians aiming for entry to conservatory programmes. The value of these scholarships is a specific amount of granted lessons to every applicant. Applicable for all grades.
- ❖ **Diversity Scholarships** for students who represent countries currently not represented at AMADEUS International School Vienna. The value will be decided based on financial means of the applicant. Applicable for all grades.

SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

AMADEUS Academic Scholarships are awarded by a Selection Committee on an annual basis. The Committee evaluates the student's progress after the initial scholarship year and students are considered for an extension of the scholarship; if successful, students can maintain a scholarship for the duration of their studies at AMADEUS. AMADEUS Academic Scholarships exclude boarding/entry/insurance/residence permit fees. They are applied to the Academic tuition fee or agreed Academy programme, and cannot be deferred to areas of scholarship for which they are not intended.

AMADEUS Music and Arts Academy Scholarships are awarded by a Selection Committee on an annual basis. This scholarship covers the costs of the Music and Arts tuition and is available to all students who are on the professional track for Music or the Arts.

AMADEUS Diversity Scholarships are awarded by a Selection Committee on an annual basis. This scholarship is awarded to students who represent countries that are not yet present at AMADEUS. This scholarship covers the published AMADEUS tuition fees. However, it may cover boarding fees based on the financial means of the family.

HOW TO APPLY

Interested applicants are required to fill out the **Scholarship Application form**.

APPLICATION TIMELINE

Application deadline for 2022-23 Academic year is 01 March 2022.

Decisions will be made by the end of April 2022.

Second round of scholarships will be awarded in May 2022, should any scholarships remain available.



APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY

All AMADEUS Vienna Scholarships are awarded by a Committee, based on a student's clear record of achievement and potential for growth. Unless otherwise specified, the scholarships are open to students regardless of age, sex, or cultural background. Applications are accepted year-round. Once the scholarships have been awarded for a given academic year, applications may be considered for the following academic year. The school reserves the right to withhold the available scholarships if candidates are not considered suitable. English language proficiency is required but may be dependent on the specific scholarship, grade level, and age of the applicant.

APPLICATION GUIDELINES

Applicants are encouraged to submit a portfolio highlighting evidence of the following: academic accomplishments, range of skills, international-mindedness and, if applicable, excellence in Music and the Arts. A portfolio may include photo/video material, recordings, certificates, and/or copies of awards. In order to be considered for a scholarship, applicants must correctly fill out all relevant sections in this application form and include all relevant documents listed below. **Applications with unanswered questions or incomplete documentation will not be considered for a scholarship.** Applications are free of charge and must be submitted via email to: admissions@amadeus-vienna.com

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- ❖ A complete, signed **Scholarship Application form**
- ❖ A complete **Application form on OpenApply** (for external applicants)
- ❖ Copies of the applicant's **most recent report cards/achievement reports**
- ❖ **Portfolio of work/Curriculum Vitae/Biography**
- ❖ **English language proficiency exam** results (if available)
- ❖ Copy of valid **passport(s)** and/or national identification card(s)
- ❖ Documentation outlining **annual household income** is required for the past two years
- ❖ **Personal Statement**

International students must show eligibility for visa requirements and a projected timeline for obtaining the visa.

AMADEUS Music and Arts Academy Scholarships

- ❖ Musical audition/Interview (if required, provided by AMADEUS Music and Arts Academy)

Depending on the artistic area, the application must include:

- ❖ A video recording of one or more recent music or dance performances by the candidate on a flash drive, website or YouTube channel link
- ❖ An electronic portfolio of visual arts work
