Our educational programme for children aged 3 to 18 (Early Years – Grade 12) is taught in English and is based on the globally recognised International Baccalaureate (IB). We believe that education is a process, full of opportunities to explore, discover, create, develop, and enrich the students' knowledge, skills, and perspectives.

Alongside our excellent academic curriculum is an innovative **Music and Arts** Programme. We support our students in choosing the creative path best suited for their individual talents and goals, with an entry point for all students. 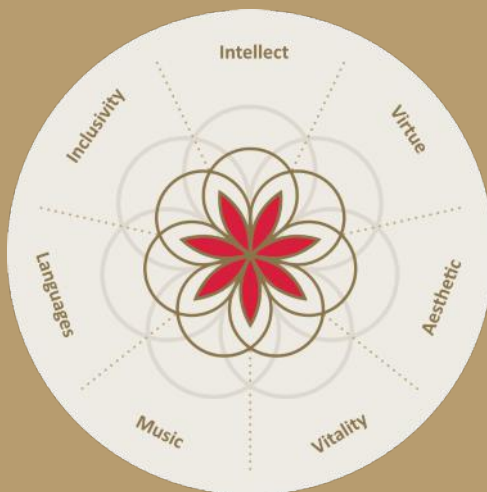

THE INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE (IB)

AMADEUS International School Vienna is authorised by the International Baccalaureate Organisation (IB) as an IB World School. Our IB programme is divided into the Primary Years Programme, the Middle Years Programme, the Diploma Programme, and the IB Career-related Programme. Our teachers regularly participate in IB professional development and training to grow as educators and lifelong learners.

The comprehensive and world-renowned IB academic framework has clear aims and values. Its major objective is *“international mindedness”*, an awareness and appreciation of the positive aspects of cultural differences.



AMADEUS ACADEMICS

In essence, we believe to ‘accompany’ means to walk alongside young people as they grow and develop. This provides students the freedom to make their path their own, whilst ensuring the correct measures of pace, support, challenge, and inspiration along the way.

To reach one’s highest potential takes a positive and caring environment. As part of our commitment to high quality international education, we pride ourselves on stimulating and engaging lessons with personalised attention.

AMADEUS Vienna is a truly international campus where multiple languages can be heard every day. The main language of instruction is English. English language support is also provided. As the language of our host country, German lessons are required up to Grade 10 and offered at both mother tongue and foreign language levels. We also support the development of our students’ mother tongue languages. Moreover, we offer Russian, Spanish and Chinese.

Information technology is an important part of contemporary learning. We provide next generation learning by offering our younger students iPads and our older students MacBooks to complement coursework and develop their technological skills.

EARLY YEARS CENTRE

EARLY YEARS CENTRE (AGE 3-5)

Our **AMADEUS Early Years Centre** is a kindergarten that welcomes children of ages 3-5 years old from all around the world. We foster a safe space for all the different cultures and value the importance of every students' mother tongue. In our kindergarten we communicate with our students and families in the English language.

Our Early Years Centre prepares the students for school. Therefore, our kindergarten works closely together with our Primary Years Programme for children aged 6 to 11.

REGGIO EMILIA LEARNING APPROACH

We celebrate child-centred learning. We follow a Reggio Emilia inspired approach and believe in the competence of every child as well as the importance of engagement in learning. In our Early Years Centre, we are all learners and teachers at the same time. We learn with and from each other.



THE DAILY LIFE AT AMADEUS EARLY YEARS CENTRE

- Our kindergarten opens at 8:00 in the morning and our day ends at 15:20.
- We provide a shuttle bus service for interested families.
- Our kindergarten consists of classrooms with infrastructure for all types of active learning.
- We enjoy playing on our playground twice every day; irrespective of the weather.
- Our kindergarten provides freshly prepared morning and afternoon snacks as well as daily choices of lunches, prepared by our wonderful in-house catering team.
- All students have their own locker for their shoes and outdoor clothing, as well as a personal drawer inside the classroom for any personal belongings and school work.
- We offer the possibility of additional afternoon care to 17:00.

PRIMARY SCHOOL

AGE 6–11, GRADES 1–5

The primary years form the foundation for a child's future learning. We offer a challenging academic education in a creative, warm, and holistic learning environment that enables children to reach their full potential. We see the world as a classroom and thus much of the teaching in the primary grades is done outside the traditional setting.

THE CORE PYP SUBJECT AREAS:

- Languages (English & German)
- Social Studies
- Science
- Mathematics
- Arts (Visual Arts, Music, Dance, Drama)
- Physical, Social, and Personal Education



AFTER SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

The complementary AMADEUS Vienna Clubs are optional after-school activities for primary students. We offer a wide range of clubs including gardening, technology, art, sports, dance, and cooking. All courses are taught by AMADEUS Vienna teachers or qualified external staff. These enable students to explore new talents and deepen existing ones.

WHAT MAKES OUR PRIMARY SCHOOL UNIQUE?

- One incredibly important pillar is **vitality**. Health education is taught through all subjects and general school life. This includes a robust physical education programme, time outdoors, nutritious homemade food, a positive school climate, and an emphasis on social development and wellbeing.
- In alignment with the IB Primary Years Programme our learning is inquiry-based and trans-disciplinary, creating a strong foundation for Project-Based Learning, which is the focus in later grades.



The flexibility of the IB Primary Years Programme allows us to meet the requirements of Austria's national curriculum for primary schools.

EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING

The Signature Experience Programme consists of those unmissable experiences at each year group which are designed to facilitate growth, and target a specific element in the students' developmental journey. These include residential trips for every grade level, special focus weeks and events throughout the year, such as Summer Wilderness, Winter Wilderness, Hut-to-Hut Snow Snowshoeing, Learn to Sail, Summit Experience and many more.

SECONDARY SCHOOL

AGE 12-18, GRADES 6–12

Our Secondary School Programme places students on a path of learning and self-responsibility within an inspiring and positive learning environment. We encourage initiative and help our students build character, confidence, and cross-cultural competence.

In our Secondary School we offer three academic sections: the IB Middle Years Programme (Grades 6–10) and the IB Diploma Programme (Grades 11–12), or the IB Career-related Programme (Grades 11 - 12)

WHAT MAKES OUR SECONDARY SCHOOL UNIQUE?

1. **Signature Experience Programme** that aims to complement students' classroom work and further enhance their personal and social development.
2. Our commitment to **Inquiry-Based Learning**, an educational methodology that enhances skills through student-driven inquiries that emphasise curiosity, teamwork, problem solving, and reflection.
3. The **Mentor system** at AMADEUS delivers on our promise of accompanying young people and personalised education. Throughout Secondary School, every child is assigned in small groups of 10-12 students to a Mentor teacher who is responsible for supporting and monitoring each child's holistic development. Mentor groups meet for 35 minutes at the beginning of each school day to track progress, reflect on learning and explore a range of important personal, social, and emotional health-related topics via our innovative micro-lesson format. This programme is inspired by the latest research in positive psychology in order to draw out the best in young people and help them thrive.



IB MIDDLE YEARS PROGRAMME (MYP)

The Middle Years Programme (Grades 6–10) is designed to support students to *“learn how to learn”*, empowering them to become lifelong learners. The world is a place of responsibility and opportunity, and we inspire students to become principled and pro-active actors within it.

The MYP has two primary goals: guiding adolescents to become creative, critical, and reflective thinkers and helping them develop qualities of “international mindedness”.

SECONDARY SCHOOL

IB DIPLOMA PROGRAMME (DP)

AMADEUS Vienna is an authorised IB World School. The IB Diploma is a highly regarded qualification that is recognised by universities in more than 140 countries. In this rigorous two-year Diploma Programme (Grades 11–12), students begin to focus on what interests them most and are supported in their preparation for higher education at universities and other tertiary institutions. There is continuous evaluation during the Diploma Programme, which concludes with final examinations that are assessed by external IB evaluators.

THE CORE DP SUBJECT AREAS:

- Group 1: Language and Literature
- Group 2: Language Acquisition
- Group 3: Individuals and Societies
- Group 4: Experimental Sciences
- Group 5: Mathematics
- Group 6: The Arts



The DP ensures that students have a breadth and depth of knowledge by allowing them to select courses from the six subject groups. To complete the DP and extend the students' skills and development each of the following elements is also required:

- **The Extended Essay:** An independent research project where students conduct an in-depth investigation into a topic of particular interest.
- **Theory of Knowledge:** An interdisciplinary subject in which students examine the nature of knowing and share views on a variety of issues.
- **Creativity-Action-Service:** A core DP component requiring students to undertake real creative tasks, activities, and community service projects outside the classroom.



AFTER SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

Secondary students have access to a range of after school activities including mother-tongue language instruction, math support, sports teams (basketball, football, volleyball), recreational activities (such as running, yoga, chess, and theatre), clubs (including Model United Nations or our sustainability team) and a full range of music, dance, and art options from our Music and Arts Academy.

TOP IB EDUCATION WITH FOCUS ON MUSIC

IB CAREER-RELATED PROGRAMME (IB CP)

AMADEUS Vienna is currently offering the International Baccalaureate Career-related Programme with a special focus on **music**.

With the IB CP, students get to focus on their music career whilst receiving a top international academic education. This provides the perfect pathway for students who wish to become professional musicians, or otherwise go on to study music at the university.

AMADEUS Vienna is the first school in Austria and the only school in the EU that offers the IB Career-related Programme with focus on Music.



In the two-year programme the students study core IB academic subjects, alongside undergraduate level music studies. This will provide the student with a BTEC International Level 3 in Music and International Baccalaureate Career-related Programme Certificate.

Moreover, we offer a preparation year for students who need to develop their English language skills before beginning the Career-related Programme.

AMADEUS Music and Arts Academy (AMAA) allows students to develop their interests and explore their talents in the areas of music, visual arts, theatre and dance.

Music and the Arts are the common languages of humanity and the essence of Viennese society. However, one does not have to be a specialist to enjoy and be enriched by music. Our programmes nurture appreciation, provide enrichment, and enable specialisation:

- **Appreciation:** All students benefit from having more music, art, dance, and theatre creatively embedded into their curriculum.
- **Enrichment:** Students can opt to take music, art or dance lessons from university level professors within their academic schedule.
- **Professional:** Students are supported into a music or arts career path and given expert professional guidance to catapult their future careers.

Participation in the progressive programme contributes to the personal and social development of our students, developing physical and mental resilience, grit and determination. Students who complete each challenge can be justifiably proud of their achievement as they gain a greater understanding of their capabilities on their path to achieving their full potential.

'FIRST CLASS' BOARDING

A ONCE IN A LIFETIME EDUCATIONAL EXPERIENCE

We are aware that boarding is a new experience for many of our students. Together with the boarding staff members we strive to make AMADEUS Vienna an incredible educational experience and major time of personal growth. It is possible to become a full boarder starting in Grade 6.

We follow international best practice child protection and safe-guarding procedures. We have boarding parents on campus during all non-school hours. Our house parents have pedagogic degrees and years of professional experience.

The boarding experience is fun and enriching. Our boarding students learn independence, leadership, and how to be part of an international community. Within the boarding programme there is something for everybody. Our boarders have access to music practice rooms, academic mentoring, explorations of Vienna, sports training, hiking, skiing and much more. They learn to maximise their time and they thrive!

Food is an important part of feeling comfortable away from home. Our students can enjoy food from our own chefs, who prepare a variety of international food on site. All meals for our boarding students are served in our school social dining area. If necessary, we are able to accommodate special food requirements.

EXCLUSIVE BOARDING FACILITIES

Our brand new state of the art boarding facility has girls and boys residing in separate sections, and the rooms are typically shared by two students. Each spacious room has a private en-suite bathroom, individual workspaces as well as WIFI access with filters for age-appropriate internet use. The house provides a balance between comfortable communal areas where boarders can connect and private quiet areas for relaxing and studying. The facilities include a large dining room, small kitchens, social lounges, an outdoor patio, and more. From the rooftop you can enjoy the incredible panorama view of Vienna's skyline and the surrounding mountains.

CELEBRATING CULTURAL DIVERSITY

At AMADEUS, we acknowledge the importance of a diverse school community representing the world beyond the campus and this is especially true in boarding. Our boarding students and staff celebrate differences and embrace similarities, sharing perspectives and creating a truly global boarding experience.

We have a good balance of cultures, nationalities, and religions which provides an unprecedented opportunity to learn in a culturally diverse environment and developing important interpersonal skills.

SERVICES, RESOURCES AND FACILITIES

SCHOOL SERVICES

To foster a family atmosphere and healthy lifestyle, we gather together in our **dining hall** to enjoy fresh meals cooked by our in-house chefs. Good nutrition is essential to student health and balance. Our students receive a morning snack, hot lunch, and an afternoon snack. Breakfast and dinner is also provided to our boarding students. Vegetarian options are always available and religious and dietary concerns are accounted for upon request. “Mahlzeit!”

Two separate **libraries** serve our Primary and Secondary students. These spaces are conducive to reading, studying, and doing homework. During **Study Hall**, teachers are always present to assist students with their work and provide them with guidance and learning support.

As a multicultural school, we encourage and support the development of our student’s mother tongue languages through the **Mother-Tongue Programme**. Mastering one’s native language creates a foundation for further language acquisition and is also important for student identity and cross-cultural understanding.

We also offer an **English as an Additional Language (EAL) Programme**. Based on the students’ English skills, they may be placed in our *English Academy* to ensure that they receive the language support they need in order to reach their full potential.

Our **School Nurse** and **School Counsellor & Special Educational Needs Counsellor** are on hand to ensure the physical as well as the emotional wellbeing of our students.

To best prepare our students for the future and guide their academic and professional pursuits, we provide University and **Career Counselling**.

A **School Shuttle Service** is available upon request to take students to and from school.

RESOURCES AND FACILITIES

To support the students' learning, MacBooks or iPads are provided to all our secondary students for the entire academic year. Our primary students are given iPads to aid certain lessons.

Our facilities span multiple buildings on a safe school campus. We provide the following facilities: modern classrooms with purpose-built science rooms, libraries, sports hall, recital hall, sound studio, music practice rooms, Steinway pianos, ballet room, theatre hall, visual arts studio, spacious boarding rooms with en-suite bathrooms, boarding student lounge, and a dining hall.

We also offer our students with superior facilities at the Sportzentrum Marswiese for PE classes and sports events. The premier sport centre provides various amenities such as 3 basketball courts, 3 tennis courts, 1 climbing hall and more.

ALUMNI NETWORK

AMADEUS Vienna has an impressive network that stretches around the world in over 10 different countries, on four different continents, over both hemispheres.

Our AMADEUS Vienna graduates study a variety of different fields, including: Engineering, Architecture, Law, Music, Art, International Business, Mathematics, Finance, Psychology, Physics, English Literature, and many more. Our graduates are well rounded students;

- they are people of good moral character

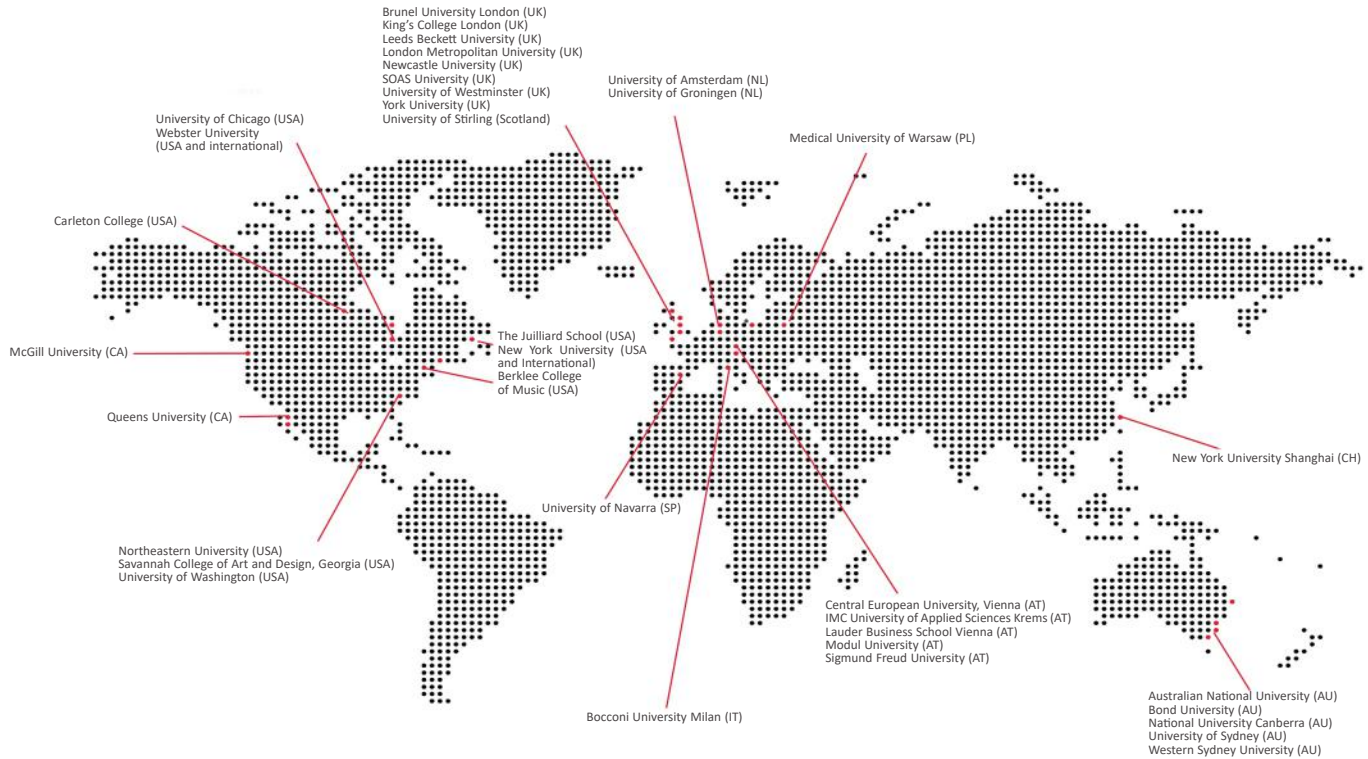

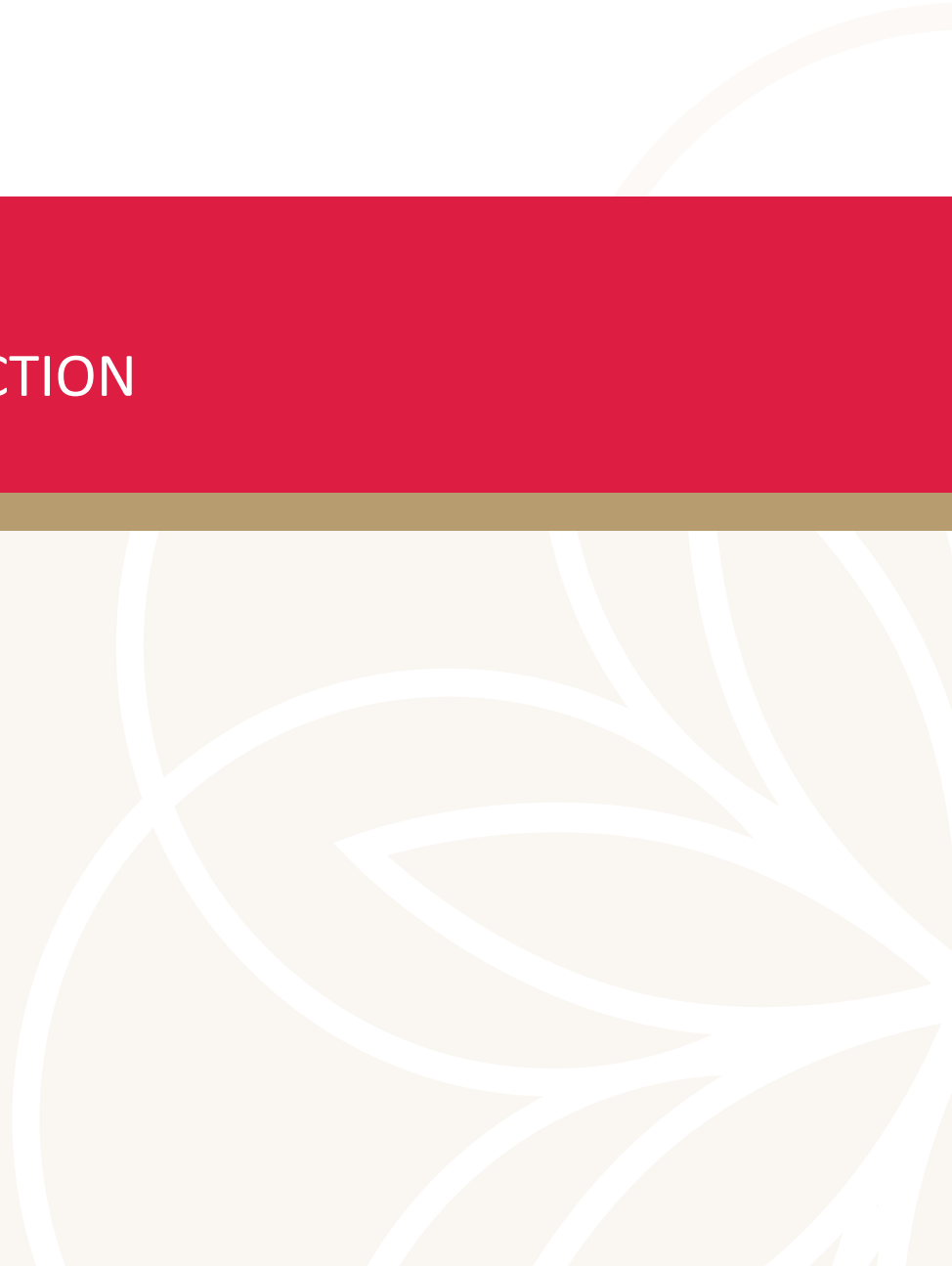
