# Uniform Guidelines

## PRIMARY

### Primary (Early Years 1 to Grade 5)

#### Uniform

Students in the Early Years and Primary School may choose between the polo shirt or full formal uniform most of the time. Generally, EY and Primary students wear the polo shirt, as it allows the greatest freedom of movement. All students must wear the formal uniform on special school days with performances and assemblies as advised by the Head of Section.

#### Formal Uniform pieces (with suggested quantities):

##### *One of:*

- School formal shirt with logo
  - School formal tie with logo
- or**
- School formal blouse, with logo
  - School formal scarf, with logo

##### *Four of:*

- School navy polo, with logo (Early Years)
- or**
- School white polo, with logo (Primary School)

##### *Three items from the following list, according to personal preference:*

- School red shorts
- School cargo pants
- School red trousers
- School red skort, with logo
- School red pinafore dress, with logo

##### *Two items from the following list, according to personal preference:*

- School navy V-neck pullover, with logo
- School navy cardigan, with logo

##### *Footwear:*

- Shoes in navy or black colour with closed toe. Leather is preferred, but other materials are acceptable as long as they align with the spirit of the uniform and comfort.
- Plain navy or white socks, **or** navy tights / leggings
- All Early Years and Primary students are required to keep a pair of indoor shoes **or** slippers at school to change into every day after being outside. Wet weather shoes **or** trainers are not allowed inside but can be worn to school and for outdoor play.



## Change of Clothes for Primary Students

Students from EY1 to EY3 must keep a change of clothes and underwear at school. As the Primary classes enjoy a lot of outdoor lessons and activities, we recommend keeping a pair of wellingtons (rain boots), and a rain jacket at school. In winter, all Primary students should bring a snowsuit, hats, gloves and appropriate shoes or boots.

All uniform items must be clearly labelled with the student's name

## Hair and Jewelry

Hair should be clean and tidy and not affect vision. Extreme hairstyles which draw attention through cut, colour, added products, etc., are not permitted. Jewelry should not be worn or kept to a minimum.

## Requirements for Physical Education

For PE, students may wear personal sporting items except for PE T-shirts.

These should be appropriate for sports and include a combination of the following:

- Plain navy or black shorts, gym tights or track pants (navy shorts for Primary Students)
- PE T-shirt (available from school's uniform supplier) or short sleeved polo shirt
- School Hoody (available from school's uniform supplier) - **to be worn during PE only**
  
- Indoor shoes with non-marking sole
- Outdoor shoes suitable for running
- Appropriate swimming costume
- Light weight rain jacket

The PE teachers and trainers may request a change of sports clothing if it is deemed inappropriate. This may include inappropriate cuts, logos, and/or slogans.

For Primary students, the PE kit should be brought to school in a cloth bag each Monday. The kit can remain at school for the week and be taken home on Fridays for washing. In the interest of safety, please ensure that your child does not wear any potentially dangerous items such as necklaces, bracelets or earrings that they cannot take off themselves. We also require the use of a hair band if your child has long hair.

## Winter Jackets and Coats

Jackets and coats may be worn when the environmental conditions require it. These should be plain navy blue or black, without large logos or slogans, in keeping with the style of the uniform.

Personal jumpers, pullovers, sports jackets, sweaters, cardigans, zip ups, turtle necks, quarter zips, ponchos, vests, V-necks etc. are not allowed. The school pullover may be worn over the shirt or polo (but not without it).

4 x Polo shirt  
2 x Pullover, cardigan  
3 x trousers, skirts/skorts  
2 x PE t-shirt 1

1 x formal skirt or dress pants  
1 x scarf or tie  
1 x blouse or dress shirt  
1 x hooded jumper

**(optional and to be worn during the PE classes only)**
