

# **PRIMARY SCHOOL (EARLY YEARS 1 TO GRADE 5)**

## Uniform

Students in the Early Years and Primary School may choose between the polo shirt or full formal uniform most of the time. Generally, EY and Primary students wear the polo shirt, as it allows the greatest freedom of movement. All students must wear the formal uniform on special school days with performances and assemblies as advised by the Head of Section.

# Formal Uniform pieces:

One of:

- School formal shirt with logo
- School formal tie with logo
- School formal blouse, with logo
- School formal scarf, with logo

Four of:

School navy polo, with logo (Early Years) or

or

• School white polo, with logo (Primary School)

### Three items from the following list, according to personal preference:

- School red shorts
- School cargo pants
- School red trousers
- School red skort, with logo
- School red pinafore dress, with logo

Two items from the following list, according to personal preference:

- School navy V-neck pullover, with logo
- School navy cardigan, with logo
- Slipover, with logo

Footwear:

- Shoes in mostly **navy** or **black colour** with closed toe. Leather is preferred, but other materials are acceptable as long as they align with the spirit of the uniform and comfort.
- Plain navy or white socks, or navy tights / leggings



• All Early Years and Primary students are required to keep a pair of indoor shoes or slippers at school to change into every day after being outside. Wet weather shoes or trainers are not allowed inside but can be worn to school and for outdoor play.

## **Change of Clothes for Primary Students**

Students from EY1 to EY3 must keep a change of clothes and underwear at school. As the Primary classes enjoy a lot of outdoor lessons and activities, we recommend keeping a pair of wellingtons (rain boots), and a rain jacket at school. In winter, all Primary students should bring a snowsuit, hats, gloves and appropriate shoes or boots.

All uniform items must be clearly labelled with the student's name.

### Hair and Jewelry

Hair should be clean and tidy and not affect vision. Extreme hairstyles which draw attention through cut, colour, added products, etc., are not permitted. Jewelry should not be worn or kept to a minimum.

### **Requirements for Physical Education (NEW FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2024-25)**

Primary and EY PE Uniform consists of following items:

- AMADEUS PE T-shirt in navy (cotton and dry-fit version available)
- AMADEUS PE shorts in navy
- AMADEUS tracksuit in navy
- AMADEUS lightweight rain jacket (navy)
- Indoor shoes with non-marking sole
- Outdoor shoes suitable for running
- Appropriate swimming costume

PE uniform garments are available for purchase from the school's uniform supplier.

In Primary School, the PE uniform is to be worn on the days students have PE lessons. On PE days, students should come to school wearing their full PE uniform and do not need to change.



In the interest of safety, please ensure that your child does not wear any potentially dangerous items such as necklaces, bracelets or earrings that they cannot take off themselves. We also require the use of a hair band if your child has long hair.

## Winter Jackets and Coats

Jackets and coats may be worn when the environmental conditions require it. These should be plain navy blue or black, without large logos or slogans, in keeping with the style of the uniform.

AMADEUS soft shell rain jacket is available for purchase from the school's official uniform provider, Der Walter.

Minimum recommended number of items to ensure a neat and correct uniform can be worn every day in the Early Years and Primary:

- 4 x Polo shirt 2 x Pullover, cardigan, 3 x trousers, skirts/skorts 1 x PE uniform
- 1 x formal skirt or dress pants
- 1 x scarf or tie
- 1 x blouse or dress shirt
- 1 x hooded jumper (optional)
