NOTES TO PARENTS

Welcome to Term 1 Afterschool Activities (ASA)! We are looking forward to our students joining us from 15:30 - 17:00, Monday through Thursday as we run, relax, and refresh at the end of our school days.

As you select your ASA for Term 1, please keep the following items in mind:

Sign-ups for ASA will take place from Tuesday, 27 August through Friday, 30 August 2024.

Changes to selected ASA, but no additions, will be allowed from Monday, 2 September through Thursday, 12 September, 2024.

Dropping an ASA will be allowed through Thursday, 19 September 2024.

First day of Term 1 ASA will be Monday, 2 September 2024.

Last day of Term 3 ASA will be Thursday, 12 December 2024.

If an ASA is under-enrolled, the school reserves the right to discontinue that ASA. In such an event, the students and parents or guardian will be notified and given an opportunity to select an alternate ASA. If no alternate ASA is selected, the student must be picked up at the end of the school day, at 15:20.

If an ASA is over-enrolled, students will be placed in the ASA on a first-come first-served basis from the sign-up date and time. A waiting list will be created and if a place opens for a student on the waiting list, the student and parents or guardian will be notified.

If your child is signed up for an ASA, please arrive promptly to pick up your child. Each ASA ends at 17:00 and parents or guardians must already be present at school when the students are dismissed. Repeated late pick-ups may result in your child being removed from all ASA for the remainder of the term.

All students on campus after 15:20 must either be supervised by their parents or guardians or enrolled in an ASA. Please note that students are not allowed to wait on campus for siblings who are in an ASA without either parental supervision or being enrolled in an ASA themself.

If your child misses two or more of the same ASA without explanation, an email will be sent to parents or guardian to inquire about the circumstances. If your child misses the same ASA a third time without explanation, the student may be disenrolled from that ASA. If this occurs, notice will be sent to the parents or guardian before the next day of that ASA that the student is no longer enrolled and must be picked up at the end of the school day, at 15:20.

If your child is unruly or disruptive to the detriment of the teachers or other students in the ASA, the ASA lead teacher or Experiential Learning Coordinator will make contact with the parents or guardian of the student to determine the appropriate course of action going forward. If your child continues to be unruly or disruptive, the ASA lead teacher or Experiential Learning Coordinator will make contact with the parents or guardian of the student a second time and may disenroll the student from the ASA. If this occurs, the student must be picked up at the end of the school day, at 15:20.

G1 - G5 Board Games (max. 15 students)



G3 - G5 Climbing Club (Additional cost)




G3 - G5 Performance Club (max. 18 students)
