



Signature Experience Programme Overview





The Signature Experience Core Programme are those unmissable experiences at each year group which are designed to facilitate growth, and targeted at a specific element in the students' developmental journey. These include residential trips for every grade level, special focus weeks, and events throughout the year. These experiences are fundamental to the student experience at that Grade level.

SHARING Summer Wilderness

The first year in the Primary Years Programme is all about sharing experiences with newfound friends. Many opportunities await Grade 1 students, with sports day, ice skating and the school choir. Grade 1 students will also join the Summer Skills Experience, enjoying a fun-filled day of swimming at the local pool.

PIONEERINGWinter Wilderness

Students in Grade 2 will be ready to build on their first years at school. They will navigate their way with courage through fresh challenges and discover new experiences. Students at this age are steadily increasing the boundaries of their worlds and will encounter 'cool' new adventures in the winter wilderness week.

INDEPENDENCE Journey to the Medieval City

Grade 3 is a pivotal moment in the journey and represents the border between lower and upper childhood. Students will participate in their first school led overnight experience to an Austrian medieval city.

RESPONSIBILITY Exploring Mozart's State

Grade 4 students will find themselves ready to feel a sense of responsibility. With this in mind, Grade 4 will start the year with a music and arts-inspired residential experience in Salzburg, which the students will plan. Grade 4 students will also begin preparing for their transition journey in Grade 5 as they experience a campus camp out.

TRANSITION Hut-to-Hut Adventure

Students in Grade 5 will complete a rite-of-passage journey as they participate in a hut-to-hut journey in the Austrian mountains. This journey is a back-to-basics experience with limited comforts and conveniences. This prepares them to face challenges and change with courage and optimism, and to see opportunities on new horizons.

TEAM WORKWater Competency

Students in Grade 6 focus on teamwork with the signature experience of developing water competency skills at Mondsee.

They will develop the ability to cooperate and empathize with others, to offer meaningful contributions to a group, and to be open to leading and learning with a sense of justice.

CONFIDENCE Basecamp Experience

Students will develop their self-confidence alongside the virtue of transcendence in an Austrian basecamp full of adventurous activities. They will focus on things like; being comfortable with who I am, what I like, and how I get things done; transcending the weight of the collective with emerging gratitude, hope, humour, and an appreciation of beauty and excellence.

EXPLORATIONTrip to Innsbruck

Students at this age need to explore and discover the world around them to deepen their sense of humanity. The site of our learning will be the historic city of Innsbruck. Students will nurture their curiosity about the world and intention to see, feel, and experience it with love, kindness, and social intelligence.

PURPOSE Service Immersion

Students will travel to work first-hand in a service learning project benefiting young people. Through this experience, our students will contemplate their sense of self, and their understanding of how this self relates with their best imagined possible futures, emphasizing temperance. They will also visit a number of nearby historical sites from recent conflicts

MISSION Summit Experience

Students will begin their IBDP years with a formation journey that focuses on mission and wisdom. They will return to the Rax Alpen, where they previously hiked in Grade 5 and snow-shoed in Grade 9, to plot their course and ambition for the IB programme; emphasizing creativity, curiosity, judgment, perspective, and love of learning.




Oceans & Earth Expedition Grade 9 - 12


Visual Arts Students will spend three days in autumn exploring exhibitions from Architecture, Cinema, Music, Dance and Film.


