SCHOLARSHIPS & AWARDS

INTRODUCTION

AMADEUS International School Vienna empowers individuals to discover and develop their talents so that they may make positive contributions to our world. AMADEUS Vienna Scholarships provide the opportunity for students, regardless of age, sex, religion, nationality, culture, and other factors, to pursue an excellent academic and arts education that leverages the school's unique international environment and host country opportunities. The programme is based on recognising all-around student excellence. Applicants are required to demonstrate achievement in academics and the arts, as well as to embody the values of AMADEUS Vienna at the highest level.

CATEGORIES OF AWARDS AND SCHOLARSHIPS

1. ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS

Description: Cover tuition fees (full or partial amount) for students in Grades 9-12 who demonstrate outstanding academic performance.

Selection criteria: Academic excellence, letters of recommendation, personal essays and standardised test scores.

Additional information: These scholarships exclude boarding/entry/insurance/residence permit fees. They are applied to the Academic tuition fee or the agreed Academy programme, and cannot be deferred to areas of scholarship for which they are not intended.

2. DIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIPS

Description: Intended for students from countries not represented in the School, in order to promote cultural diversity.

Selection criteria: From a non-represented country, demonstrated financial need, academic potential and commitment to the School community.

Additional information: These scholarships are awarded for one academic year and reviewed annually.

Value: The value of the scholarship will be determined by the financial situation of each applicant.

3. AMADEUS MUSIC AND ARTS ACADEMY (AMAA) SCHOLARSHIPS

Description: Awarded to students with exceptional talent in music or the arts.

Selection criteria: Auditions, portfolios, letters of recommendation and personal essays. These scholarships are awarded by a Selection Committee on an annual basis. This scholarship is offered based on a successful live audition. For detailed information, visit the AMAA Scholarships page.

4. AMADEUS AWARDS

Description: Recognises personal and professional growth, special talents and contributions to the School Community.

Selection criteria: Participation in extracurricular activities, leadership, community service, innovative initiatives and creative projects.

5. IBCP AWARDS (G11 and G12)

Description: Aimed at external students who wish to enter the exclusive IBCP programmes in Music or Art and Design.

Selection criteria: Portfolio of artistic or musical work, personal essays, letters of recommendation and auditions (if applicable).

6. ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE & DISTINCTION AWARD

Description: A scholarship covering 50-100% of tuition fees and 50-100% of the cost of Boarding from Grades 9 to 12.

Selection criteria: This award is for fully rounded students with exceptional academic records, a portfolio of demonstrable personal and professional achievements and projects connected to prestigious international institutions. This scholarship is available to students in grades 9 to 12 with exceptional marks on the Admissions Test during the application process.

SELECTION PROCESS/HOW TO APPLY

APPLICATION:

- **AMADEUS Students** must submit a complete application, including the required documents for each scholarship or award category. The registration of applications will be carried out through the following form: <https://form.jotform.com/252644331676359>.
- **External applicants** who are currently not enrolled at AMADEUS need to complete the school's normal admissions procedures. Start your application at <https://amadeus.openapply.com/apply> in addition to the following form: <https://form.jotform.com/252650727052353>.
- **Application Timeline:** Both applications will be open starting **01 October 2025**. The application deadline for the 2026-27 Academic year for AMADEUS Students is on **02 January 2026**. The application deadline for the 2026-27 Academic year for External Applicants is on **22 February 2026**.

Decisions will be made between March to May 2026.

EVALUATION & NOTIFICATION: A selection committee will evaluate the applications according to the established criteria. Selected students will be notified in writing.

ADDITIONAL CONSIDERATIONS

MULTIPLE APPLICATION: Students may apply for multiple scholarships or awards.

SINGLE SCHOLARSHIP: Students may only receive one scholarship, with the exception of awards and the diversity scholarship, which may be combined with other scholarships.

APPLICATION GUIDELINES

In order to be considered for a scholarship, applicants must correctly fill out all relevant sections in the application form and include all relevant documents listed below. **Applications with unanswered questions or incomplete documentation will not be considered for a scholarship.**

OBLIGATIONS OF SCHOLARSHIP/AWARD HOLDERS

Recipients of AMADEUS Vienna scholarships/awards have the following obligations towards AMADEUS International School Vienna:

- Uphold and exhibit AMADEUS Vienna's mission, values, and philosophy.
- Strive to achieve his/her fullest potential and highest academic attainment.
- Serve as a role model in terms of behaviour, manners, and inclusion, and abide by the School and house rules, including wearing proper school uniform on a daily basis.
- Respect mandatory attendance (absences must be approved by the Head of Secondary).
- Reside in AMADEUS Vienna's Boarding Programme (If so stated in the scholarship or award offered).
- Contribute skills, talents and gifts toward any AMADEUS Vienna extracurricular activities, including major productions, performances, teams, groups, choirs, ensembles as is reasonably practical.
- Promote and engage in AMADEUS Vienna community activities by participating in School events.
- Provide support to the AMADEUS Vienna Marketing & Admissions Office by promoting the school to prospective parents on campus and, upon request, during off-campus events;

SCHOLARSHIPS/AWARDS REVIEW PROCESS & EVALUATION

Renewal of scholarships will be subject to a new evaluation process and fulfilment of the established requirements. Awards and scholarships will be granted for one academic year and will be reviewed annually by a Selection Committee and may be renewed, extended or cancelled for the following academic year. If for any reason students no longer meet the requirements for the scholarship/award, the scholarship/award may be immediately cancelled during the academic year (for serious reasons) or not renewed for the following academic year.
